# Terms of agreement

- All prices exclude VAT at 20%
- It is the Sponsor's responsibility to cover all costs associated with providing all relevant branding and artwork required under the sponsorship agreement. Exact artwork specifications will be provided upon receipt of the signed sponsorship agreement.
- 50% of the value of the sponsorship will be invoiced upon receipt of the signed sponsorship agreement.
- The balance of the sponsorship deal will be due 60 days prior to the conference.
- Invoice payment terms are strictly 30 days from date of invoice.
- Sponsorship availability is limited and will therefore be allocated on a first come, first served basis.
- Agilysis Limited and Road Safety GB reserve the right to refuse sponsorship where it is considered necessary.
- Sponsors must sign and return the sponsorship agreement form upon acceptance of the sponsorship deal at the earliest convenience.
- Sponsors must communicate regularly with the conference organisers for further information, instructions, invoicing, payments, and technical procedures prior to the conference.
- Sponsors must provide all requested artwork at least three weeks prior to the conference start date.

  - At least 60 days notice from start of conference – 50% of contract
  - Less than 60 days notice from start of conference – no refund
